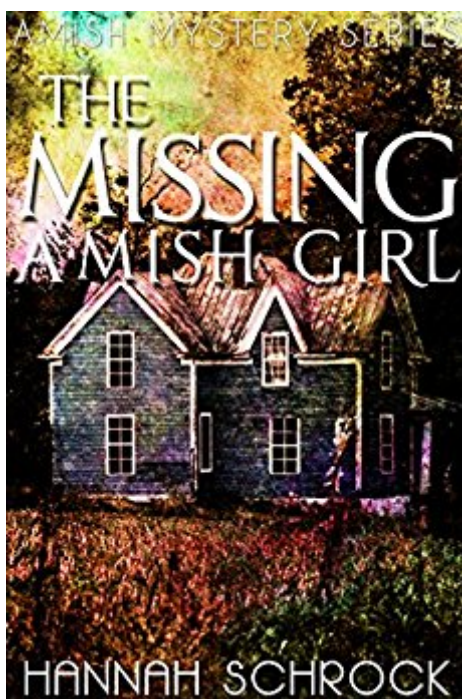

This is not a romance. It is a murder mystery. Really not Hannah Schrock's typical romance! It was dark, depressing and Eli seemed downright sinister and mean. There wasn't an ounce of romance or even happiness. It was just oppressive and sad. It started out dark and got darker I want to have something good to say, because I usually like Hannah Schrock, but this was just not her best. Stick to romance next time please Ms. Schrock..

The title and review drew me in, but the story is too simplistic for most adults. I'd recommend it more for a Young Adult reading level and even then it's a short, simple story. I read it in about 20 minutes and knew the plot outline almost as soon as the murderer was introduced and their whereabouts and demeanor described.

I try to find something good to say about every author I read. Ms. Schrock doesn't hold your attention and interest. She must be an amateur and I think she will improve with time. Not a fan of this book.

This woman is more than Amish. She's a detective who will not leave a mystery unsolved! She's willing to face the wrath of her community and place herself in life or death situations to bring the person who harmed her friend's daughter.
