

It discusses the challenge to balance the needs of wildlife with the demands of civilization. The illustrations are well drawn and clever. This book holds the interest of young children In conjunction with "Cooking the East African Way", "Folk tales & fables of the Middle East and Africa" & Florence Temko's "Traditional Crafts of Africa" it would make a great social studies unit. While I think this is a wonderful addition to a classroom or daycare I have to wonder how much use a family would get from this book. If you want to really know if this book is for you, go to your local library.
