

This book only gives you the mindset required to make connections and see patterns in information. The key to utilising the information effectively (in my opinion) is to memorise it's content and when given new information, assess it with these points in mind. Perhaps apply these skills to this book and assess for yourself whether it's contents stand up to scrutiny. I have given this book four stars because I dislike that the title brands people according to a scale which the author partially rejects and effectively puts people on a pedestal.

As the cover suggests, this book is a list of 40 principles that highly successful people follow. The author includes lots of examples from real life to explain why each of these principles is important, and how they can be applied in real life. The best way to treat this book is as a pocket guide for useful reminders on how to think, organize, and plan. Highly recommended!
